

**RESOLUTION R-2017-100**  
**LUZERNE COUNTY COUNCIL**

*A Resolution by the Luzerne County Council Awarding  
2017 Luzerne County Recreation & Conservation Fund Grant Monies*

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Luzerne County Recreation and Conservation Fund is to provide annual financial support to projects in Luzerne County that advance priorities identified in approved local, regional and/or state recreation, conservation and land use plans and/or provide programming for and promotion of the county's outdoor recreation resources; and

WHEREAS, the Luzerne County Recreation Fund is funded with the annual Act 13 Marcellus Legacy Fund dollars received by Luzerne County; and

WHEREAS, on June 27, 2017, Luzerne County Council revised the process previously adopted for the selection and award of annual receipts of Act 13 Marcellus Shale Legacy Fund dollars; and

WHEREAS, County Council has final approval authority for the award of Act 13 Marcellus Shale Legacy Fund dollars to applicants; and

WHEREAS, County Council wishes to award 2017 Act 13 Marcellus Legacy Fund dollars received by Luzerne County to applicants identified in Exhibit 'A' at the amounts set forth therein. Exhibit 'A' is incorporated as if fully set forth herein.

BE IT RESOLVED, the County Council for the County of Luzerne hereby awards the 2017 Act 13 Marcellus Legacy Fund dollars received by Luzerne County pursuant to the selection process set forth in Resolution 2017-77 to the applicants set forth in Exhibit 'A' in the specified respective amounts.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, all awards must be used by recipients for the project described in their application.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, one-half (1/2) of each award will be available to each recipient upon the adoption of this Resolution with final payment of the award balance being made to the recipient upon proof of project completion.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, unused or unclaimed funds will revert to the County's Act 13 funds if proof of project completion has not been submitted to Luzerne County within eighteen (18) months of the adoption of this Resolution.

This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.




