

**RESOLUTION R-2017-102
LUZERNE COUNTY COUNCIL**

A Resolution of the Luzerne County Council Authorizing the County Manager to Execute an Emergency Communication Tower License Agreement with the Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission regarding a Tower Location located off of Harris Pond Road, Ross Township.

WHEREAS, Luzerne County Council has authority to approve of all leases concerning real property; and

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission owns and operates a property in Ross Township, Luzerne County, known as Harris Pond; and

WHEREAS, Luzerne County has identified a need for a radio tower to address improved radio communications, redundancy, and coverage in the geographical region in which Harris Pond is located; and

WHEREAS, Luzerne County has requested use of a portion of the Harris Pond property to place, operate, and maintain an emergency communications tower and related equipment to address regional emergency communication needs to protect the public's health, safety, and welfare; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Luzerne County Council authorizes the County Manager to execute the attached Emergency Communication Tower License Agreement with the Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission.

This Resolution shall become effective 6 days after adoption.


