I think the fees used in the analysis may not be all the fees that were incurred. They don't appear to be close to the .65% annual cost that Rich Hazzouri mentioned last night.

1. Please provide me with the 2015 and 2016 contract , if any, with Evergreen Landscaping.
2. How many members of the county work force are on the levee crew, and what are their functions.

For mgr. information and rectification.

1. Lt. Foy in the sheriff's office begins his work day at approximately 7 am each day, does not take breaks or lunch and leaves each day at 2pm. He leaves for his second job as a part time policeman in West Pittston Borough. He makes a habit of going on county time , presumably in a county vehicle, to magistrates' offices to be present for arrests made while working part time. The sheriff does not have deputies who have obligations with any magistrates as I am told. I can verify this with a sign out board of duties.

2. Your operations director, Mr. Parsnick , leaves early every day to perform coaching duties at Coughlin High School. I can only verify phone calls I received from people who gave me their names that this is a fact. He usually leaves about 3:30 pm each day. I believe that is an abuse of management prerogative to take time off.
3. The sheriff himself , a few times a week, is picked up in the back of the court house around 1pm, returns an hour or so later, and leaves for the day frequently before 3:30pm. That can be verified by the fact that he was involved in a car wreck at about 3:24pm a month or so ago, within a short distance from his home.

These issues are not ones that go unnoticed. I have had numerous calls about each of these, and in two instances from public officials questioning me about these abuses.

I believe the sheriff is abusing his authority with regards to Lt. Foy and regarding his early departures. I am sure there can be instances where special consideration can be afforded, these however are flagrant. As with Mr. Parsnick, I believe his position of employment and first duties are with the county, and leaving daily certainly does not say much for our commitment to county government. I think his salary certainly should dictate that his first duty is to the county, and after those hours of commitment are fulfilled he can be free to do whatever is his pleasure. We have a rather dark image with the public now, and these careless actions do not enhance our commitment to upright this ship of state with the public.

I look forward to your attention and rectification of these issues in proper and expeditious manner.
