After reading the summation by the legal department regarding the Trump rally use of County Deputy Sheriffs, it was concluded correctly that there is no mandate law requiring use of deputies at private / public rallies, as was stated there was by the manager, but in times of a need to protect public safety or quell riots there is. THE RALLY WAS BOOKED AS A CAMPAIGN RALLY NOT A THREAT TO SAFETY OR A RIOT. It was a completely bogus assumption by the manager that the possibility of a riot was eminent and his call to mandate deputies was far beyond a common sense approach to that request. In the summation there is ONE example cited where deputy sheriff were used for events, and it was done by contract for crowd control not to prevent riots or violations of the peace. The other examples are purely legal boiler plate additions.

It seems that every time we miss step as a result of poor judgement, our legal department comes up with a "CYA" response for the administration. I was told emphatically by the manager that the law prescribed specifically that deputies can be mandated to work public / private functions. Obviously that is not true. One Pinocchio point for that tale. Further, we were supposed to receive compensation for our costs. Not received yet. Two Pinocchio points.

I am writing to you rather than embarrassing all of us with this topic at a regular meeting. What I say at the meetings is ignored by most of you so you can read this or discard it. However, if you wish to make issue of it at a meeting I would be delighted to partake in that discussion.

Every time the administration screws up, the personal legal staff of the administration comes to its aid with an OPINION that justifies the error. Again, if a discussion is needed on this topic, I will be glad to participate.

I think it would be very helpful to Council to receive monthly division reports that provide general info on the action of each division and its departments. So, a report might include statistics of number of staff employed by the division/department in each month, number of vacant positions, and statistics on the work of the division - like, how many wills processed, deeds filed/released, number of employees attending conferences or training during the month, etc.

For Corrections, it would include how many inmates were housed both in county and elsewhere(average per day); cost per day to feed/house/clothe inmates; number of incidents involving inmates etc; number of inmates placed in restrictive housing; etc. I believe that this kind of report has to be prepared for the state anyway.

An ongoing awareness of what is going on in general in that and other divisions will help us to have a better understanding of County operations, particularly as we get into budget talks. Any personnel related items would be in statistical or general terms rather than specific.

I would guess that you get a report like what I'm describing from each division on a monthly basis already. I would not expect this to be read to Council at each meeting, but sent to Council like the Budget monthly stuff is. It could also be made available on the website. It would also allow you to provide a streamlined Manager report that focuses on highlights or late-breaking news.

What we've seen since the Budget info has been presented regularly is a large decrease in the demand for specific information by Council members - if you recall what it was like 2 years ago. If Division reports were

provided to Council for discussion at the first work session of each month and Budget reports continue to be provided for the second, it would demonstrate communication between management and Council.
